

## MAINE JAZZ CAMP – 2010 APPLICATION FORM

Maine Jazz Camp is pleased to announce its thirty-second anniversary sessions. **July 11-17, 2010** will be primarily for high school students (those entering grades 10-12) and **July 18-24, 2010** will be for both high and middle school students (those entering grades 7-12). Adult ensembles .week of **July 18-24, 2010**.. Students playing any instrument may apply and are encouraged to send in a completed application early. Requests for a particular week will be considered on a first-come-first-serve basis. Enrollment will be limited to approx 60 students per session. Any student enrolling after the maximum number has been reached will be considered on a case by case basis, depending upon the instrumentation needs of the camp. A late fee of \$25 will be charged for all applications received after **June 1, 2010**.

Campers live in supervised dorms with a staff of trained counselors. Each camper is responsible for providing his/her own equipment; pianos are provided.

Tuition, room and board totals \$585 per session. Should you wish to attend 2 weeks the total cost will be \$1075. A deposit (non-refundable) of \$100 must accompany this application. Balance of tuition is due within 45 days of date of acceptance or **July 1, 2010** whichever comes first. In addition to nearly a full day of music classes, campers have scheduled recreation and rest periods. There are evening activities including concerts by staff members. Camp is held on the campus of the University of Maine at Farmington. Maine Jazz Camp is an equal opportunity educational organization. All applications for this session will be considered on teacher recommendation and the past diligence of the student.
